Weekly Cues



Elementary

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, remind them that you believe they have what it takes to be a good friend to others this week.



Meal Time

At a meal, have everyone at the table answer this question: “Have you ever had to forgive a friend? What did they do? Was it hard? How did forgiving them affect your friendship?” (Alternate: Have you ever had to ask a friend for forgiveness?)



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “What is the difference between a friend and someone you just know?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, You have forgiven us of so much. And sometimes we all do or say things we shouldn’t. Help us to forgive our friends when they hurt us, and to ask for forgiveness when we hurt them.”
